



# Features Guide

## Navigating the HomeRemote Pro Website

The HomeRemote Pro website features an **Interactive Help Tool** that provides more information about any feature or item. Hover your mouse cursor over any feature, and a help bubble will appear with more information on each item.

In addition, there is a **Help** button on the top right of each web page that gives you access to the **Online User's Guide**. You may access and print the Guide at anytime for detailed information on the entire HomeRemote Pro System.

## The Home Status Page Features

**Profile:** Shows your personal name and picture. This information can be customized in the System page under Account Details

**Sidebar:** Detailed access to each room and the modules and sensors within those rooms. Click the section to view and control your rooms. And, click the room to see your operating devices.

**Camera Viewer\*:** View any HomeRemote Pro Cameras you have installed on your system. Click the thumbnail view to activate video from each camera.

**Status:** Quickly view into all rooms and the status of each device. All programmed devices are controllable in this module.

**Scenes:** Lists the Scenes that are currently set up in your system. Activate your Scenes from this box.

**Alerts\*:** Displays all current Alerts and their status. You can manually disable or enable an Alert from this box.

**Recent Activities:** Displays the most recent activity within your home.

**Schedules:** Shows your upcoming scheduled Scenes.

\* Requires a subscription to the Pro-Level Service for Alerts and remote video monitoring

## Navigation Menu Features

### Activity Log

View all recent and past activity in your home within your system.

The Activity Log lets you view System and home events during a specific timeframe.



### Alerts (Requires Pro-Level Subscription)

Send email and text message alerts to yourself or family when specific events occur.

Select a Room to arm, then select the specific event that you wish to be notified of.

Last, select the phone numbers and email addresses you wish to use for notifications.



### Scenes/Schedules

A Scene is a group of devices with different settings that can be controlled all at once or scheduled to occur at a specific time.

Create a name for your Scene (i.e. All Lights or Wake Up) then select the details of each module for your Scene.

Set the schedule at the bottom of the page if you choose to have the Scene occur automatically.



### Device Linking

A Device Link allows one module or sensor to trigger other modules to turn on or off.

For example, you can set it so that when a door opens, all lights in your home turn on.

Follow the instructions on the setup page to set up a Device Link.



### Phones (Cell Link™ - Pro Level Service Required)

Set up your Cell Phone to control and monitor your HomeRemote Pro System.

Enter your phone number and follow the steps to activate your phone.

Set up multiple phones to give control to your family members or roommates.



### System

From the System page you can adjust your:

- Account/Profile Details
- Clock Settings
- Add/Edit Rooms
- Add/Edit Modules
- Add/Edit Cameras
- Notifications/Alerts
- Sign Up for Pro-Level
